Last week we heard from Sally Richardson, Volunteer Manager for the Naples Botanical Garden. Sally's presentation offered an interesting overview of the Garden, one of our community's true resources.

Sally explained that the Garden connects people and plants through display, education, conservation, and science. It acts as a community gathering place and venue for exploring the natural world. Resting on 170 acres just south

of Old Naples, it is comprised



of six cultivated gardens known

as "Gardens with Latitude" highlighted by 2.5 miles of walking trails and restored native preserve.

We also learned of the Garden's exciting future plans. A future "Visitor Center" will welcome every member, visitor, and volunteer. The Center will include an auditorium, gourmet cafe and retail/ticketing center-and 18,000 gallon rainwater collection tanks.
