She was a first responder during 911. Dr. Long started by thanking the Club for their service during Irma. In 1974 the Disaaster Relief Act was signed so that the Federal Government could act in emergencies. It was Jimmy Carter who brought FEMA into existence. Dr. Long went down the long list of disasters they respond to from floods, fires, oil spills. FEMA is not a first responder but they do bring all the first responders to the field, including the Department of Defense and the National Guard. FEMA does the data collection and the states manage the funds. FEMA assesses the damage and then brings people with the expertise to help with long term recovery. We are part of FEMA Region 4 based out of Atlanta and they will stay with us however long it takes to recover.


