### Fred Partin and BSU



Stephanie introduced our speaker, Fred Partin, the Executive Director of the Bonita Springs Utility. This is the member-owned, not for profit, public utility that provides water and wastewater service in our area.

In the late 1960s, a group of Bonita Springs civic leaders

saw the need for a central water system to serve the growing community and its future citizens. Bonita Springs Utilities was conceived. Organizers secured commitments from 1,000 property owners needed for the Farmers Home Administration loan to build the system. In 1970, the FHA loan for \$976,000 launched the development of a central water system in Bonita Springs

In 1981, Fred joined the utility as general manager. The water treatment plant was expanded to 3 million gallons per day.

By 1990 capacity had expanded to 6 million gallons per day and, in late 1991, BSU acquired a private wastewater treatment facility and began work to provide central sewer service to its water customers.

During hurricanes Charley and Wilma BSU provided continuous service to its water and waste water customers in spite of many days of electrical outages.

Last year the utility had assets of \$358 million and revenues of \$37 million. There were 41,000 customers using an average of 8 million gallons of water per day and 4 million gallons per day of wastewater.

Over the years several Rotarians have been active members of the board of directors. Currently, Frank Liles Jr, John Mathes, and Hank Hostetler are members. Thank you for your service and the vision that has developed this exemplary operation in our city.

After three years of work, the Rotary Club of Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii, USA, completed a US \$300,000 renovation of the Lahaina Public Library, a 57-year old structure that had fallen into disrepair

due to a lack of state funds.

The club collaborated with Maui Friends of the Library and the Hawaii State Library System to raise money, commission a redesign, remove and reshelve 35,000 books, and recruit 21 companies and more than 100 volunteers to provide pro bono services. It was the largest project in the club's history.
