The sessions are led by **RLI** qualified and trained Discussion Leaders who only serve to stimulate and facilitate discussion in harmony with the course curriculum. **RLI** attendees learn from participating in the discussion and also working with others in problem solving group exercises.

"Having leadership skills does not alone assure good Rotary leadership. An effective Rotary leader must ALSO have Rotary knowledge, perspective about where Rotary has been, where it is now going and a vision of what Rotary can be."


