*“Kae Moore, Southern Indiana’s top scorer last season, fired through 43 points Saturday night but it wasn’t enough and his teammates only added 20 as Wheatland edged New Harmony, 69-63. Moore had 18 field goals and seven charity tosses.”* **Kae Moore** stepped forward to present his Vocational Service Moment. He is now retired but does consulting for development projects. He says, “I’m basically a beggar”, having spent a 30+ year career raising money for universities and YMCAs. Before getting into the development side of the college business, Kae was a high school and college basketball coach for 10 years. As a college basketball player, he started out as a guard, played mostly forward as a junior, and as a center in his senior year despite being only 6’2”. His highlight was scoring 16 points in the last 13 minutes in a 98-92 win against DePauw.
