And singin', just singin' in the rain.



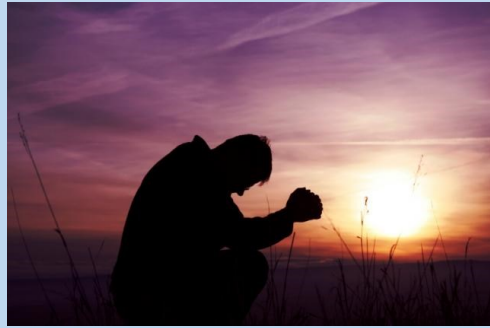

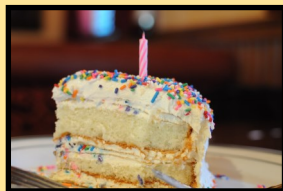
