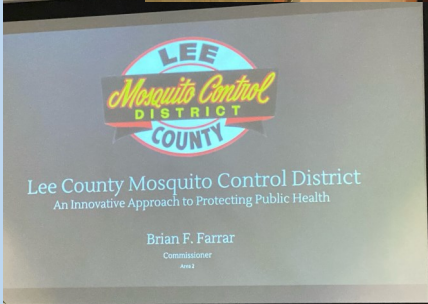
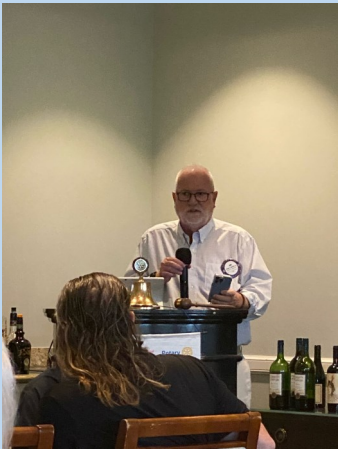

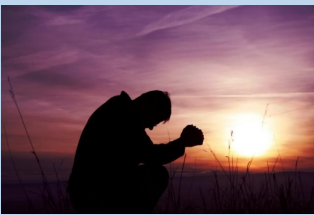
Joe's Corner
