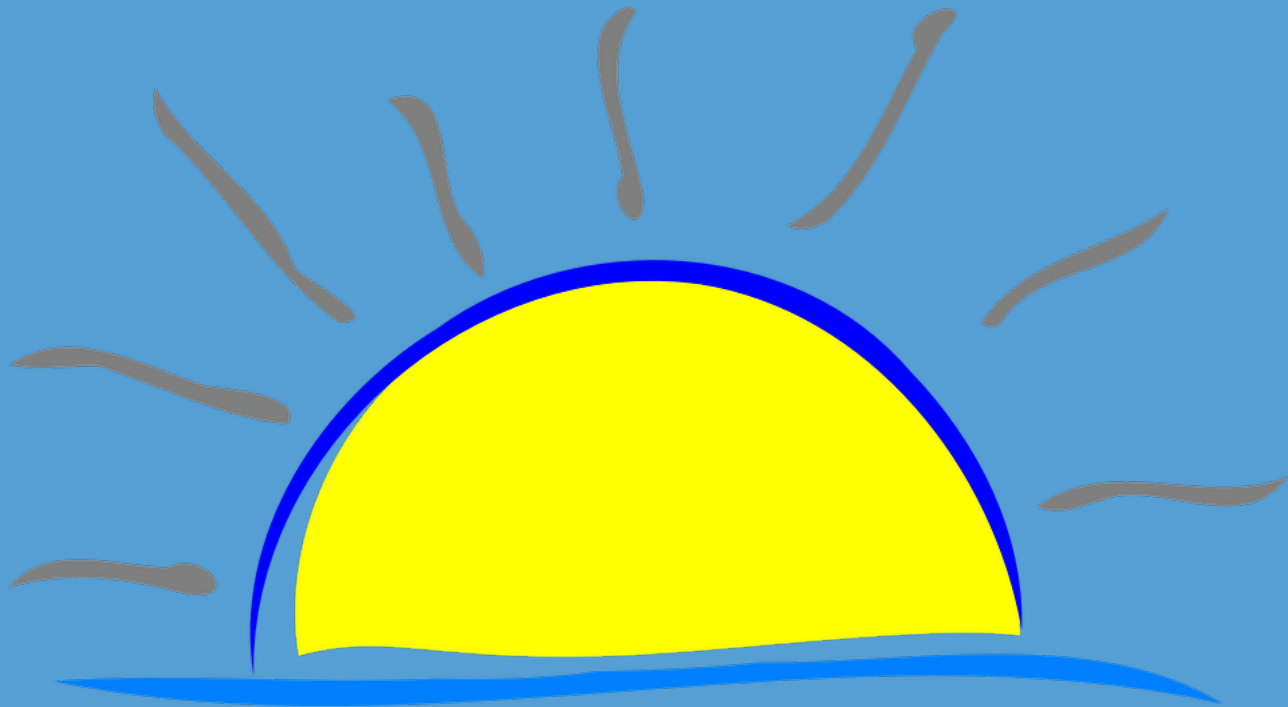

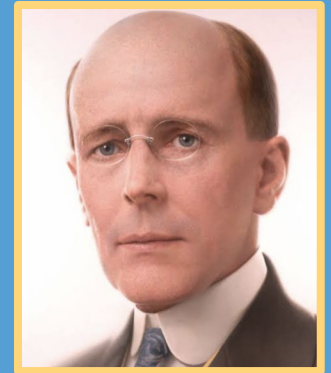

## In the beginning...

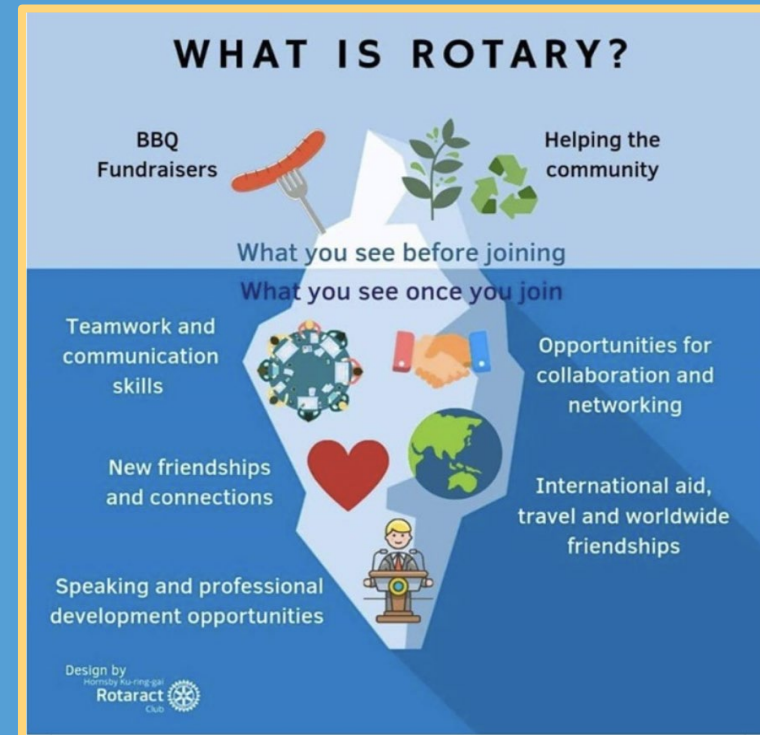
- The first Rotary Club was organized in Chicago in 1905, by Paul P. Harris.
- Harris persuaded several business associates to discuss forming an organization for local professionals.
- Paul Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey met in rotation at the offices of the members – thus the name Rotary was created.
- There are approximately 1.4 million members in over 46,000 clubs globally addressing community needs.





# Rotary is ...

- Rotary became the **world's first service club**.
- Our motto is **"Service above Self"** Rotary recognized that fellowship alone would not keep a group together — there needed to be a defined purpose.
- The first service project was building **public restrooms in downtown Chicago, IL, USA**.

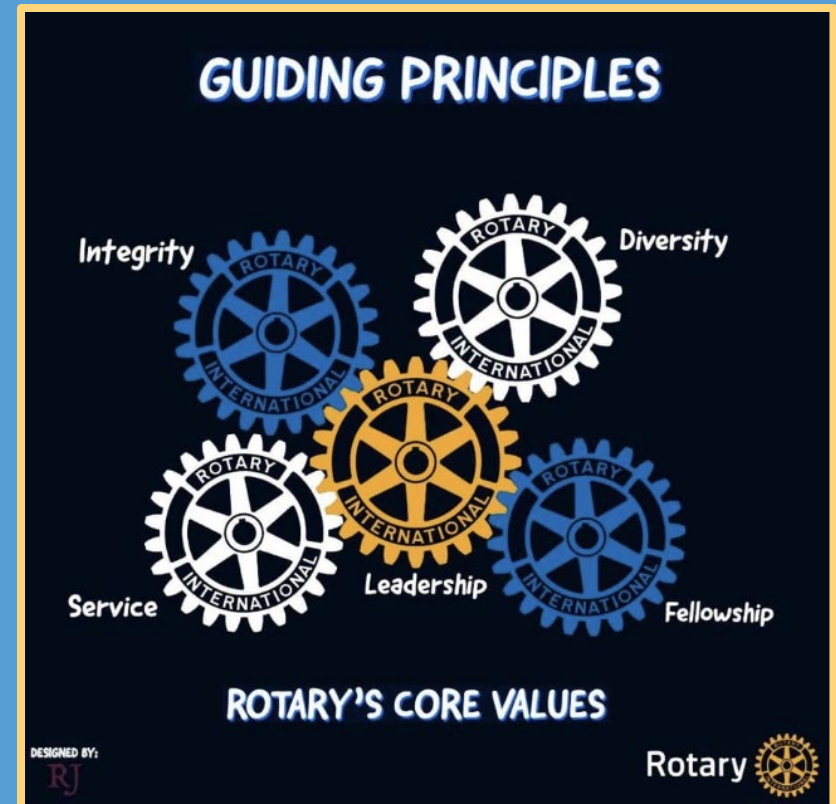






# Guiding Principles of Rotary

**Community Service** Making Bonita Springs a better place in which to live with community volunteering, reading and books. i.e., I Like Me.

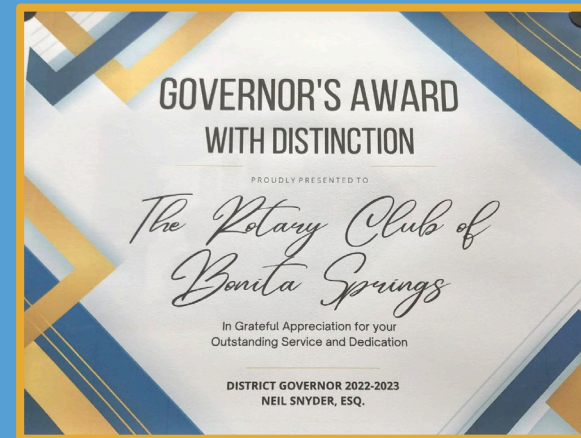
