



In the beginning...

The first Rotary Club was organized in Chicago in 1905, by Paul P. Harris.




- Harris persuaded several business associates to discuss forming an organization for local professionals.
- Paul Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey met in rotation at the offices of the members – thus the name Rotary was created.
- There are approximately 1.4 million members in over 46,000 clubs globally addressing community needs.



Rotary is ...


- Rotary became the world's first service club.
- Our motto is "Service above Self" Rotary recognized that fellowship alone would not keep a group together there needed to be a defined purpose.
- The first service project was building public restrooms in downtown Chicago, IL, USA.

Rotary Club of Bonita Springs Foundation

PURPOSE

The purpose of The Foundation of The Rotary Club of Bonita Springs is to distribute funds provided by the club and alternate donations through an application and evaluation process to local, regional, national and international charities.

In addition, a special Scholarship Fund has been established to fund Scholarships that are awarded High School Seniors in the local community each year. These Seniors are selected by a Scholarship Committee comprised of club members based on a criteria established by the committee.

STRUCTURE

The Foundation of The Rotary Club of Bonita Springs is a 501(c)(3) entity managed by seven club members elected as Trustees, that serve three-year terms, that can be extended to an additional three years by vote of the club..

A selection committee to fill Foundation positions is comprised of the past Club President who chairs the committee and two members who do not hold club office chosen by the Chair. The committee selects candidates from club members. The club votes to elect the Trustees from the candidates presented and club members who wish to be considered.
